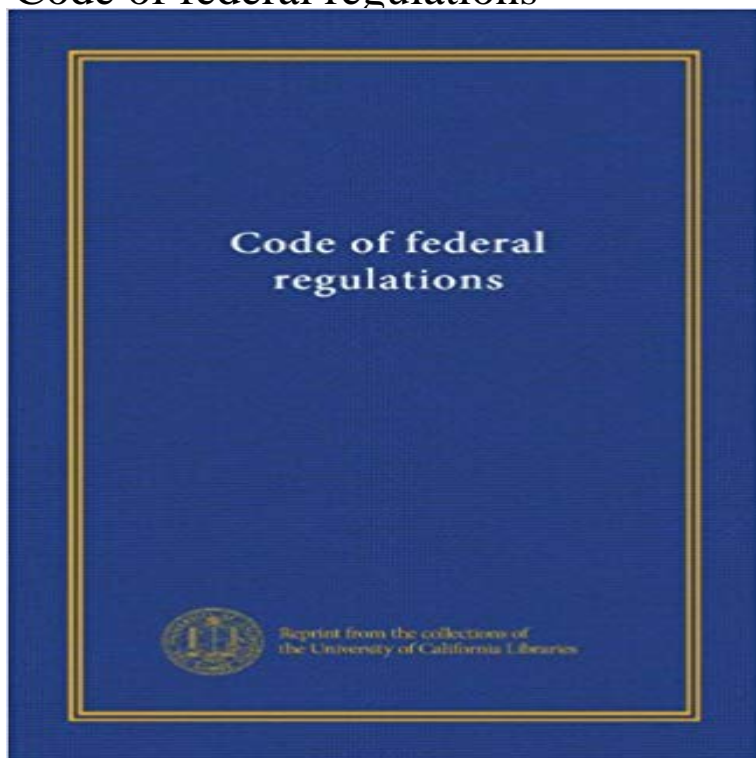


Code of federal regulations
