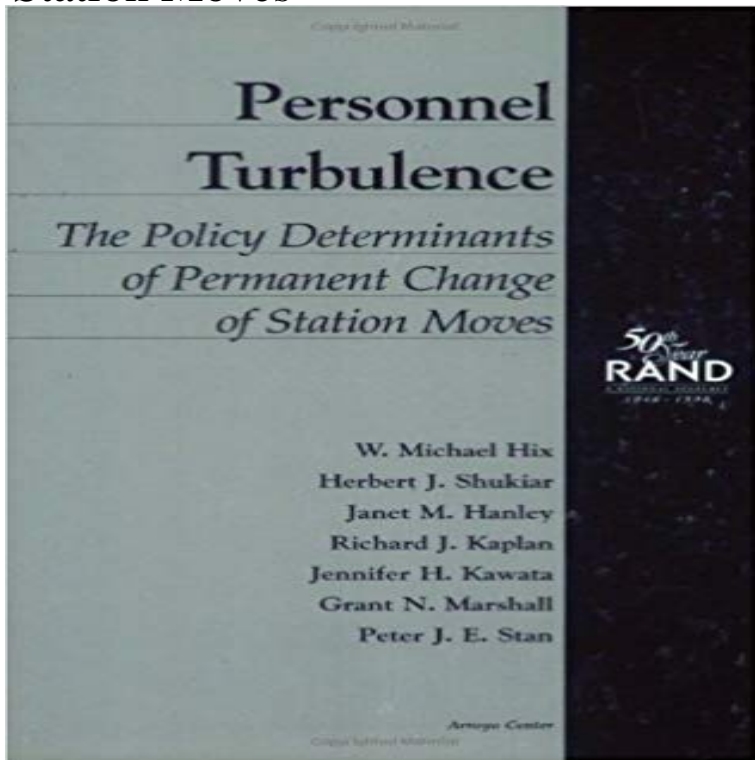


Personnel Turbulence: The Policy Determinants of Permanent Change of Station Moves
