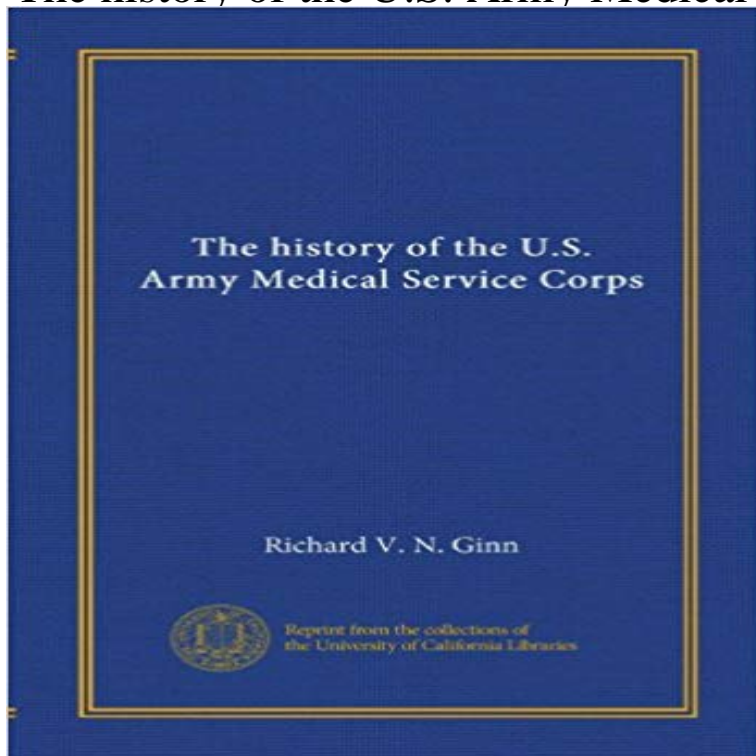


The history of the U.S. Army Medical Service Corps
