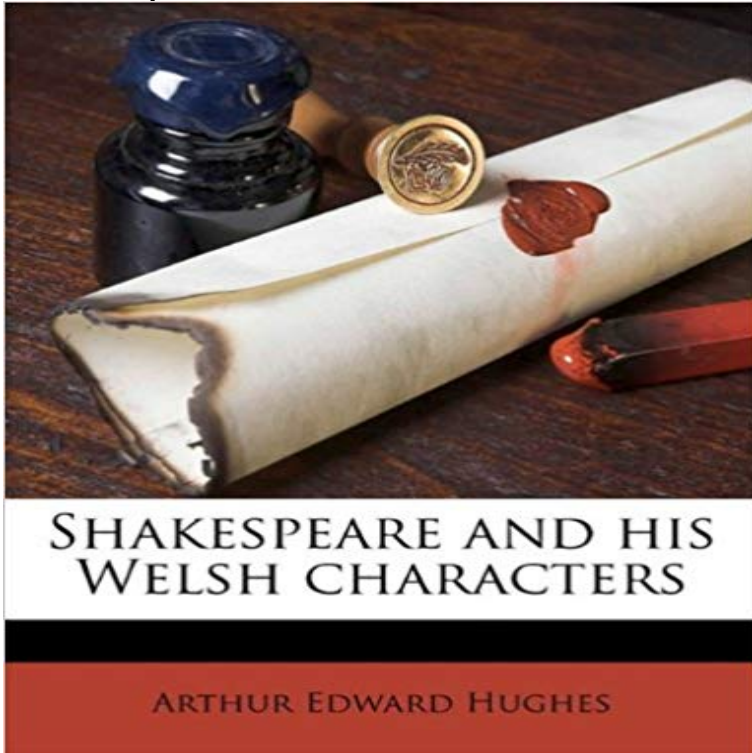


Shakespeare and his Welsh characters
