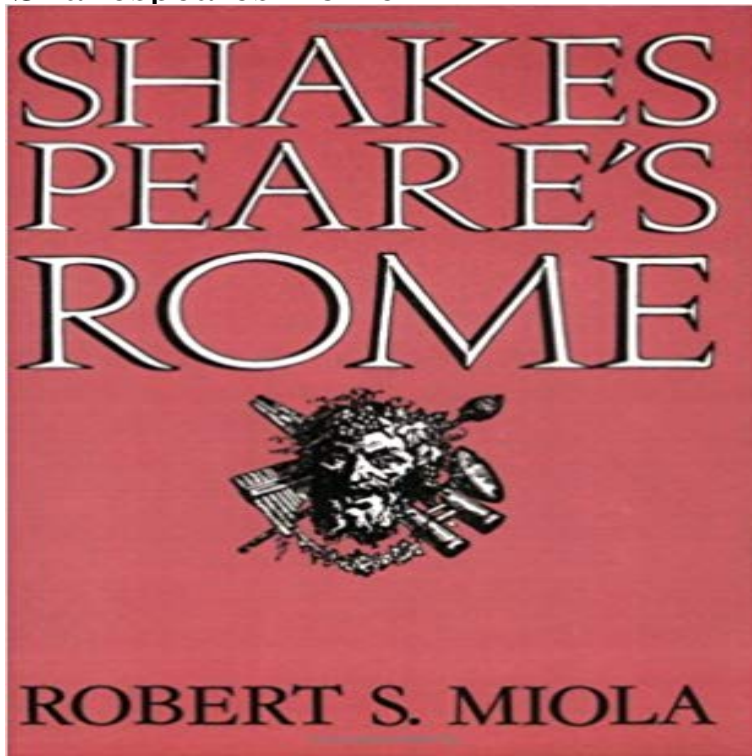


Shakespeares Rome
