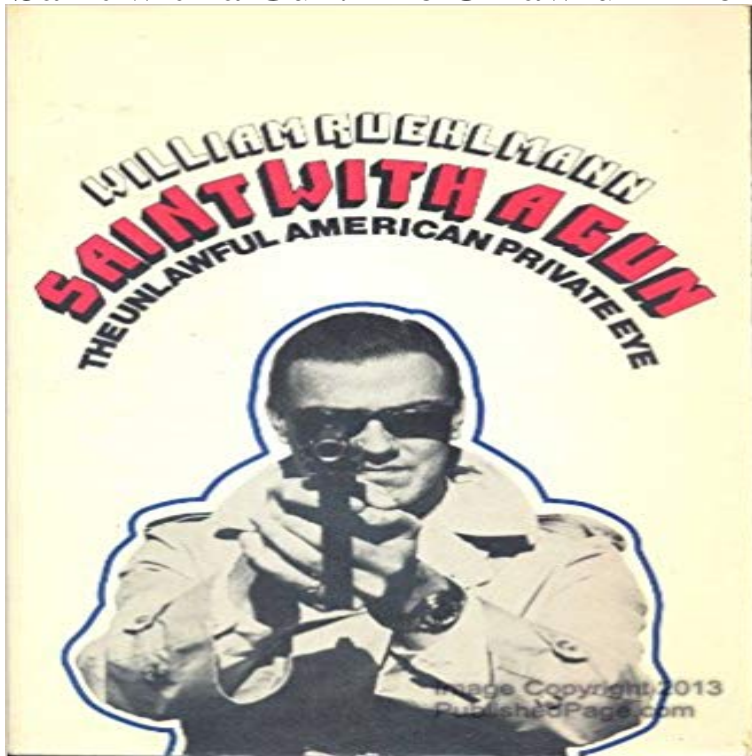


Saint with a Gun: The Unlawful American Private Eye
