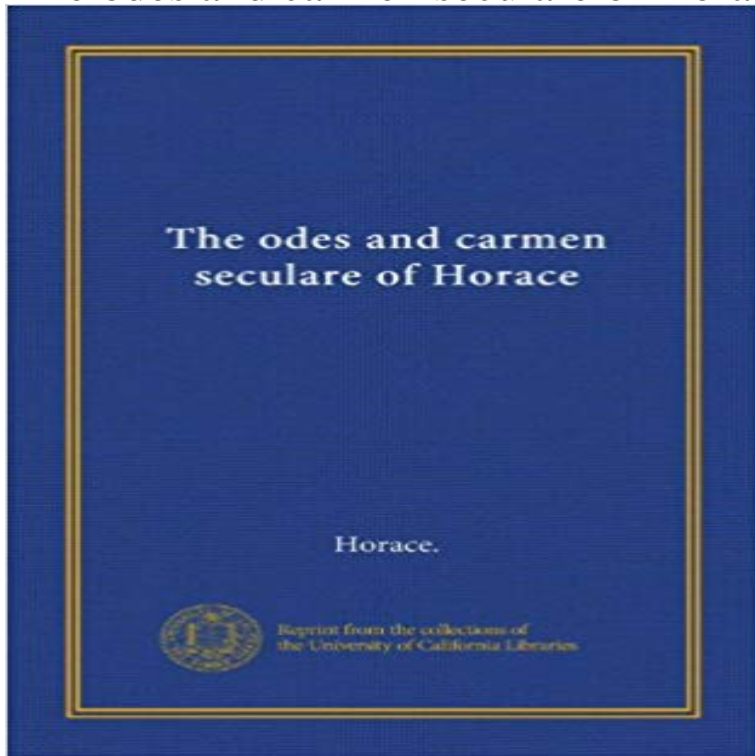


## The odes and carmen seculare of Horace
